



BOARD MEMBER JOB DESCRIPTION

Three Legal Duties*

- Duty of Care:** Directors and officers must perform their responsibilities in good faith and with the same care an ordinary person would use in managing his/her own affairs.
- Duty of Loyalty:** Directors and officers must act in good faith and in a manner which does not harm the organization to the benefit of the director or officer. Avoid any conflicts of interest or appearances of impropriety.
- Duty of Obedience:** Directors and officers must comply with the provisions of the articles of incorporation, bylaws, and state laws, and should safeguard Habitat's mission and Christian witness.

<p>As the highest leadership body of the organization and to satisfy its fiduciary duties, the board is responsible for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A demonstrated interest in the affiliate’s mission and goals; • Specific experience and/or knowledge in at least one area: human resources, planning, fund raising, building, finance, community relations, or organizational operation; • Strategic and organizational planning; • Ensuring strong fiduciary oversight and financial management; • Fundraising and resource development; • Enhancing the organization’s public image and a willingness to represent Habitat to the community • Follow Habitat’s bylaws, policies, and board resolutions; • Sign an annual conflict-of-interest disclosure and update it during the year if necessary, as well as disclose potential conflicts before meetings and actual conflicts during meetings; • Maintain confidentiality about all internal matters of the organization. 	<p>Each individual board member is expected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know the organization’s mission, policies, programs and needs. • Faithfully read and understand the organization’s financial statements. • Serve as active advocates and ambassadors for the organization and fully engage in identifying and securing the financial resources and partnerships necessary for the organization to advance its mission. • Leverage connections, networks, and resources to develop collective action to fully achieve Habitat’s mission. • Give a meaningful personal financial donation. • Help identify personal connections that can benefit Habitat’s fundraising and reputational standing. • Prepare for, attend, and conscientiously participate in board meetings. • Participate fully in one or more committees. • Commit five to ten hours per month distributed among Committee meetings - preparation and attendance, Board Meetings-preparation and attendance, special requests.
